Article I

Name

The Name of Club will be: Journal Club

Article II

Purpose of the Club

The club has been organized to: Create a space for students to express their creativity through journaling.

Article III

Authority

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV

Membership (Mandatory)

Membership is open to all SBCC Students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

Article V

Meetings

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC 217.

Article VI

Officers

President - Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings.

Vice President - Supports presidents, takes over in his/her/their absence.

Secretary - Records minutes of club meetings.

Treasurer - Keeps financial record.

Article VII

Elections

Officers shall serve 1 term and will be elected each fall semester. They are eligible for reelection and there is no limit on number or terms able to be served.

Article VIII

Amendments

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 70% of the Club members.
